

## Bar Credit Account Agreement - 2017

Any Member in good standing is eligible to open a charge account in his or her name at the Club Bar subject to the conditions that follow. Only the amount of the sale shall be put on the charge account. All accounts with balances less than \$5.00 will be billed the minimum monthly charge of \$5.00.

All amounts owed the Club will be considered past due on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month they are received, e.g., October bar bills are due on receipt of the invoice and past due effective November 25<sup>th</sup>.

Members wishing to utilize the Club charge option for bar, food, ship store or other non-dues services will be required to have a Visa or MasterCard credit card back-up on file in the office. Amounts due to the Club for bar, food and ship store and other non-dues expense will be charged to the credit card on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month following receipt of the invoice. For example, October bar bills that became past due on November 25<sup>th</sup> will be charged to the credit card December 1.

If you wish to make use of a club account to charge items as described above, please provide a credit card number, expiration date, and signature to confirm your permission to use the credit card, and return this letter to Seal Beach Yacht Club.

If you are using an American Express, it is required that you include the four digit code found on your card.
